This people-to-people delegation will focus on Cuba's contemporary and historical literature and its role within the larger creative-arts community, exploring the relationship between personal expression, history, culture and identity. We'll visit the centers of Cuba's writing and publishing communities, neighborhoods that have been the setting and source of inspiration for important literary works, World Heritage Sites of extraordinary beauty, and encounter both old traditions and 21st century Cuba. Much of our time will be spent meeting with individual writers, visiting writers' unions in four cities, and learning how the writing arts are integrated into Cuba's Socialist culture. Guided tours for deeper understanding and sense of place will also be featured. As the delegation will consist mainly of working writers, each day will include time for discussions, personal journaling and photography.

This wonderful, unique opportunity for cross-cultural engagement will reach beyond writing and literature and into the creative spirit. Participants are encouraged to bring journals, cameras, etc. to record their own inspirations and insights.
