Beginning in Havana, we will make our way west to the province of Pinar del Rio to learn about the country's struggle to take control of its food system in the face of global market exclusion.

10:30	We are off to learn about the power of organic urban farms in Cuba as we visit Alamar, on the outskirts of Havana and exchange withlocal gardeners. At the Organopónico Vivero Alamar we will engage with one of Havana's largest and most successful urban garden, a Unidad Básica de Producción Cooperativa (Basic Unit of Cooperative Production). Covering 11 hectares in Alamar, a residential suburb, the allotment's rows of vegetables are overshadowed by grey Sovietstyle blocks of flats. Though small, the garden (really more of an urban farm) is incredibly productive. As well as fresh vegetables, fruits, ornamental plants, seedlings, timber and medicinal and spiritual plants, the cooperative also produces dried herbs, condiments, garlic paste, tomato sauce and pickles; vermicompost, compost and substrates; goat and rabbit meat and mycorrhizal fungi.
