historical development of the capitol, and about the Master Plan for Restoration of Old Havana through the salvaging of old buildings, tourism for restoration development, and the accompanying social services

for local residents.

11:00 am Guided City Tour of Old Havana. Our guided tour includes a brief history of the city's important sites with

a focus on the diverse architecture of the city. Our walk takes us through Havana's oldest neighborhood to learn about the historic, architectural, and cultural significance of this area which was declared a World Heritage Site in 1982 by UNESCO. Explore the four main plazas of the 18th-century colony: Plaza de Armas, which originally housed the main administrative buildings of the colony; Plaza Vieja, the oldest

of the plazas; Plaza de la Cathedral, site of the baroque cathedral of Havana, and Plaza de San Francisco, site of the basilica of San Francisco and the old Havana stock exchange. One highlight today is a stop at the Fototeca and the Taller Gráfica in Old Havana.
