**September 22** **Mexico Rocks and Tres Cocos Excursion** **B, L**

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8:00 am Breakfast and morning at the resort.

10:30-3:30pm Mexico Rocks & Tres Cocos is a beautiful snorkel spot located between the Belize Barrier Reef and Ambergris Caye. The snorkel area at Tres Cocos is well known for having some of the largest brain corals and elkhorn coral along the reef. The reef at Tres Cocos is as shallow as four feet and is a great spot for both beginner and experienced snorkelers. These Belize snorkeling locations are also known for their abundance of marine life including conch, banded shrimps, arrow crabs, flounders, stingrays, yellowtail snappers, angelfish, damselfish and hawksbill turtles

**September 24** **Caracol Ruins Excursion** **B, L**

9:00am Depart for Caracol! We drive through tropical pine forests before descending into lush rainforest. Caracol dates back to the classic period and is Belize's largest and most spectacular Mayan city. There are over 35,000 structures, 5 plazas, 4 palaces, 3 temples, 24 stelae, 2 ball courts, reservoirs, causeways and an astronomical observatory. We also visit to the Rio Frio Caves and enjoy a swim in the crystal clear Rio On Pools.
