9:00 am Explanation of the history and development of Havana by an architect/urban

planner, explanation of the social and political effects on the development of the

Cuban Capital (Miguel Coyula requested).

II:ooam Enjoy a guided Walking City Tour of Havana, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Delegates also have time to engage with Cubans at their art studios, galleries and markets where participants will meet with Cuban artists and find out first hand



how artist negotiate between the tourist market, a socialist economy and new opportunities for individual entrepreneurship. Visit the four major historical squares of Cuba. Historian's massive efforts to restore Old Havana buildings, attract tourism and new investment, and improve social services for local residents. See buildings and homes in different stages of reconstruction, meet with neighborhood residents. Learn about how tourism impacts economic good

12.30pm Lunch at la Bodequita del Medio in Old Havana and visit to the **Taller Grafica**.

2:30pm Learn about the Cuban Revolution with a guided visited to the renovated Museum of the Revolution.

## Saturday, April 29th

**Excursion to Matanzas** 

8:00am We are off for the provinces of Matanzas known for its AfroCuban culture and legacy is called the "City of Bridges" or the Athens of Cuba. We stop at the Bacunayagua Bridge on way to Matanzas town (about 2 hrs).

10:00 am We learn about the history of the region at the Castillo de San Severino (1735) as we walk through this fort and learn about the Slave Route and the legacy of slavery in Cuba. This fort was declared a National Monument in 1978 and is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy a performance by AfroCuba there

#### Mariel to Las Terrazas

8:00am

Check out of our hotel, and we are off Westward. Leave for the coastal and port city of Mariel. We will visit a recent Bio-tech facility. A guide with share with us about the Zona Franca and the history of the area. Learn about Cuba's current research on COVID and the creation of a variety of new medicines and approaches to health care as we will visit a local BioTech facility.

12:30pm

Leave for Las Terrazas UNESCO Biosphere Reserve for an excursion to "Las Terrazas" / Pinar del Rio Eco-Community and Sustainable Development site in the Sierra del Rosario Mountains . We will engage with representatives from CITMA (the Cuban Ministry of Technology and the Environment) to learn about Cuba's efforts to promote sustainable development. Dialogue about how communities in habitat reserve areas and mountain and coastal zones are involved in environmental and habitat protection, and to learn about local environmental pressures and conservation efforts by the Cuban people. We will learn about their community ecotourism project and their hotel La Moka. Enjoy a hike through the community, exchange with local artists, and hike to experience the reforestation project. Enjoy a lunch (on your own a la carte) at a local restaurant upon arrival.

This morning we start out with a leisurely walking tour of the farmlands and crops is included today. Learn more about the simple lifestyle here and see first hand the farmers who grow tobacco for some of the most expensive cigars. Viñales is a small and charming rural village. Later head to an ecological farm, Finca Paraiso for a tour and for lunch there (plan 20 Euro). We will also learn how cigars are rolled (and give a shot at it yourself.) After lunch we will have a free time, up to 2 hours, for either horseback riding or biking through the area. Here we get a chance to see the countryside of Cuba, and how their traditional ways of farming and living have been maintained throughout the years.
