9:00am Meet the ladies of **Sunbula**, a Fair Trade organization that supports Palestinian craft producers –women's groups, artisan cooperatives and disabled people's organizations. By promoting traditional handicrafts locally and internationally, they support economic self-help efforts of those living in difficult conditions in the occupied West Bank and Gaza Strip.

II:ooam Yad Vashem Museum visit. While a somber experience, it is routinely rated as one of the top most important things to do in Israel. This incredibly moving experience gives us glimpses into the history of this area, opens up conversations about our world in present times, and casts a vision for the world we want to create in the future.

Store/Refugee Camp.

2:30pm Enjoy a brief lecture about the History of the Nations and States of Israel and Palestine by a representative from the Alternative Information Centre (AIC).

Afterwards we will enjoy time to support fair trade products and local artisans (Bethlehem Fair Trade Artisans (BFTA) is a non-profit Interfaith Palestinian Non-Governmental Organization established in 2009 and registered by the World Fair Trade Organization in 2012.)
