He also created numerous short films, including *Santeria: Life in the Religion*, and a photo book on Santeria in Cuba entitled *Babalawo: Father of Mysteries*. Joe leads photo trips to Bhutan, Tuscany and Cuba. He is currently a photography adjunct at Sussex County Community College in Newton, NJ.
