Guided visits to important museums and cultural centers will also be featured. Saturday, Dec. 30th (B, L)

Breakfast on your own at the hotel.

9:00am "Havana Today and Tomorrow" Enjoy a briefing by Cuban Architect to understand the history and development of the Capital.

11:00am Enjoy a **guided walking tour of Old Havana**. Learn about the Master Plan for Restoration of Old Havana through the salvaging of neglected buildings, tourism for restoration investment, and the accompanying social plans. Additionally there will be dialogue with staff about the importance of UNESCO World Heritage Sites, national patrimony, restoration and urban planning.

1:00 p.m. Lunch in Old Habana (El Figaro Paladar) and experience the City Historian's massive efforts to restore Old Havana buildings, attract tourism and new investment, and improve social services for local residents. See buildings and homes in different stages of reconstruction, meet with neighborhood residents as they engage in selling arts and cafts.

3:00pm Visit **the Museo de Bella Artes**, the Cuban Fine Arts Museum for an overview of Cuban contemporary arts.

5:30 pm We drive to the **Forteleza ortaleza de San Carlos de la Cabaña**, known as La Cabaña (Fort of Saint Charles), is an 18th-century fortress complex, the third biggest in the Americas, located on the elevated eastern side of the harbor entrance in Havana, Cuba. The fort rises above the 200-foot (60) hilltop, along with Morro Castle (fortress).

Dinner reservations at a local paladar Canonzoa

8:30pm Canoñazo Ceremony. Soldiers dressed in 18th century uniforms fire a cannon over Havana bay at precisely 9 p.m. o'clock. It is a historical reconstruction dating back to the colonial era. Back then, the cannon fire announced the official end of the day and the time to close the city gates for the night. Here you will have a lovely view of Old Havana as the restaurant is located in Fortaleza de San Carlos de la Cabana. At the time of its construction in the 1770s it was the largest fort the Spanish had ever built, as well as the most costly. Following the occupation by the British, who used this location to secure the port for their side, the Spanish set about building Fortaleza de San Carlos de la Cabana. We will also enjoy live music.

We are off to our excursion to the **Las Terrazas community**. Enjoy a community guided visit this ecological community and environmental education center. Participants will meet with reserve officials and community and student volunteers working in the reserve. We will receive an overview of the history of the project and then have time for lunch will be at El Romero.

Afterwards we will hike through the community to meet with **local artists Jorge Duporte, Lester Campa, Henry Alamo and Ariel Pinelli.** Opportunity to interact with the local community, visit local artists in their studies and engage in leisurely people to people exchanges.

Saturday, January 6th Excursion! Vinales Valley (B) Breakfast and leave for Vinales Valley.

A walking tour of the farmlands and crops is included today. Learn more about the simple lifestyle here and see first hand the farmers who grow tobacco for some of the most expensive cigars. Vinales is a small and charming rural village. Visit for Benito's to understand the paring of cigars and rum.

Later head to an ecological farm for lunch (it will be about \$20 USD) there to support the farmers directly. We will also learn how cigars are rolled (and give a shot at it yourself.)

After lunch we will have a free time, up to 2 hours, for either hiking, horseback riding or biking through the area. Here we get a chance to see the countryside of Cuba, and how their traditional ways of farming and living have been maintained throughout the years. (Please note it is 15 cuc as option fees).



After we have lunch we will visit the Cueva del Indio or Prehistoric Mural and park.

After we take a group picture at the look out over the Mogotes we return to the Hotel Moka.

Lunch and Excursion with the Muraleando Community Art Project, a community-based art programs in Havana, inspired originally by local neighborhood artists who taught art "in the streets." Outdoor murals and sculptures, depicting fanciful celebrations of Cuban life, were a natural outgrowth of these art classes. In a country where nothing is disposable and everything is useful, broken typewriters, old telephones, tire rims, wrought-iron chair parts - all were fair game to weld and paint and turn into sculpture. The original efforts were made in conjunction with cleaning up trash dumps that had collected throughout the neighborhood. Found art objects, parks and murals now replace piles of trash and serve as gathering places for residents and visitors. We will request to meet with local artist and co-founder of the project, Manuel Díaz Baldrich Manolo. The Muraleando Community Art Project welcomes international support and aid in the form of art and educational supplies.

3:00pm Visit to the **Cuban Literacy Museum** for an overview of the mass literacy movement in Cuba, which is now a model in other countries around the world. Exchange with Luisa Campo.

Tuesday January 9th Adios or Optional Excursion To Varadero (B, D)

Breakfast on your own at the hotel and transfer to the airport for those that like.

For others....

9:00 am After breakfast we check out and we depart for the province of Matanzas, just to the east of Havana. Matanzas known for its AfroCuban culture and legacy is called the "City of Bridges" or the Athens of Cuba".

Before we leave Havana we visit the Church of Regla to see the Black Madonna, also knowns as Yemaya and thank our time in Havana. Then we are off! We stop at the **Bacunayagua Bridge** on way to Matanzas town where we will visit a book making work shop the **Ediciones Vigia** to exchange with local artists and writers. Next we are off to learn about the history of the region at the **Castillo de San Severino** as we walk through this fort and learn about the Slave Route and the legacy of slavery in Cuba. This fort was decared a National Monument in 1978 and is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We will request a presentation by the performance arts group, **Afrocuba or another folkloric group.**

Our afternoon finds us in the resort town of **Varadero**. Here we will checkin at your all inclusive resort!
