

## Celebrating 60 Years of Jazz in Havana!

## April 27- May 5th, 2025

## **Summary:**

Join us to celebrate KCSM's 60 years promoting 24-hour jazz in the Bay Area. This Support for the Cuban People Journey provides you with a way legally to travel to Cuba while learning about the rich history of Cuban music and jazz as curated by KCSM. Explore diverse musical genres, Cuba's visual and graphic arts, and explore the relationship between personal expression, community development and musical collaboration. We'll visit studios, galleries, World Heritage Sites of extraordinary beauty, and neighborhoods that have been revitalized through imaginative art projects. Much of our time will be spent meeting with individual artists and musicians, visiting community art projects, and seeing how music is integrated into the public sphere in Cuba's Socialist culture. Guided visits to important museums and cultural centers will also be featured.

11:00am Enjoy a lively **briefing by architect Miguel Coyula,** an architect and urban planner for an overview of the History of Cuba and its Capital.

1:00pm Lunch at **La Calesa Real Paladar**.

3:00pm Experience the City Historian's massive efforts to restore Old Havana buildings, attract tourism and new investment, and improve social services for local residents. See buildings and homes in different stages of reconstruction, meet with neighborhood residents as they engage in selling arts and crafts on this **guided walking tour of Old Havana**. Learn about the Master Plan for Restoration of Old Havana through the salvaging of neglected buildings, tourism for restoration investment, and the accompanying social plans. Additionally there will be dialogue with staff about the importance of UNESCO World Heritage Sites, national patrimony, restoration and urban planning. One highlight of the day is a visit at the **Taller Grafica**.
