9:00am Briefing by a local historian to share with us the history of this island nation "From Taino to Colony to Commonwealth"

11:00am We have a special historic walking tour of Old San Juan this morning to bring history alive. Highlights include the Old City Plaza de Colón, San Felipe del Morro Castle, San Cristobal Fort El Palacio de Santa Catalina (La Fortaleza), La Casa Blanca (Juan Ponce de Leon's Residence, the first Governor of Puerto Rico), La Catedral de San Juan La Iglesia de San José (the oldest Spanish Church in the Americas), El Convento de los Dominicos, La Puerta de San Juan and the El Paseo de la Princesa.

2:30pm Our city tour concludes with a visit to **Castillo San Felipe del Morro**, (El Morro) sits atop a high promontory overlooking the entrance to the San Juan Bay. It is the result of the efforts of Spanish engineers over a period of more than 250 years and is one of the largest fortifications built by the Spain in the Caribbean.

The town of Loiza, and the community of Piñones, reflects the richness of the island's Afro-Spanish culture and traditions, especially in the form of music, food and crafts. It is considered by many locals "the soul of the island" celebrating Puerto Rico's traditional AfroCaribbean community and culture.
