Highlights include the Old City Plaza de Colón, San Felipe del Morro Castle, San Cristobal FortEl Palacio de Santa Catalina (La Fortaleza), La Casa Blanca (Juan Ponce de Leon's Residence, the first Governor of Puerto Rico), La Catedral de San Juan La Iglesia de San José (the oldest Spanish Church in the Americas), El Convento de los Dominicos, La Puerta de San Juan and the El Paseo de la Princesa.

2:30pm Our city tour concludes with a visit to **Castillo San Felipe del Morro**, (El Morro) sits atop a high promontory overlooking the entrance to the San Juan Bay. It is the result of the efforts of Spanish engineers over a period of more than 250 years and is one of the largest fortifications built by the Spanish in the Caribbean.
